QUALIFYING

- Qualifying period: April 1 October 31, 2025
- Riders must have competed in at least two (2) HVHJA member shows, including one (1) show away from their home barn, in order to be eligible for Finals.
- Leadline riders need only have competed in one (1) HVHJA member show.
- The top 15 riders in the HVHJA Medal standings will qualify to compete at Finals.

- Submit your entry online at hvhja.org/finals-entry-blank
- Paper entries will not be accepted
- Payment is required at the time of entry

Deadlines:

- Entries close Wednesday, October 22, 2025
- Post-entries accepted until October 29, 2025





FEES

- Division Total: \$150
- Leadline: \$75
- Pre Mini Stirrup & Mini Stirrup: \$100
- (All fees include Warmup & Finals classes)

Additional Fees:

- Post-entry fee: \$50
- Scratch fee: \$50

Scratches made after the closing date will be accepted with a veterinarian or doctor's note and board approval.

Refunds will be issued minus the \$50 scratch fee.

- **High Point Jumper Horse:** Awarded to the horse or pony earning the most points over the course of the season across all jumper divisions.
- **High Point Rider**: Awarded to the rider earning the most points over the course of the season across all equitation divisions.
- Brisingr Perpetual Trophy: Awarded to the year-end champion of the Modified Child/Adult Hunter Division.
- Jenny Brooke Road Perpetual Trophy: Awarded to the year-end champion of the Low Hunter Division.
